

## Guide to Reading Construction Drawings

### Brief outline of the training

This session is targeted to give each delegate improved knowledge of how to understand the details within construction drawings. The session is very interactive with delegates completing a workbook as the session progresses.

### This session is aimed at

This session is for anyone who wants to improve their knowledge of reading and understanding the details with various construction drawings. Recommended to attend this training are employees new to the industry who need to have a better understanding of extracting information from drawings.

### Numbers

The session can be delivered either via the team's platform or in a classroom environment. Depending on the size of the training room we usually say a maximum of 16 delegates.

### Outline programme

The aim of this session is:

To be able to identify the basic details when reading construction drawings  
The objectives of this training.

- Be more confident in identifying the several types of drawings (plans, detail, plot and section) projections
- Identifying the various hatchings, symbols, abbreviations
- How to use a scale ruler
- Looking at the basic drawing equipment required.
- Section 38 and 104 agreements

### 1 Day Session Programme

- The session is a one-day session starting at 9.00am -16.30pm.
- The session is very interactive.
- Each delegate will complete a workbook with various exercise as the session progresses.
- We finish off the session by looking at various drawings and extracting information from each drawing. (Not delivered in the Team's platform session).
